



Mountain Skills Semester Booking and Cancellation Policies

Please read both pages and understand these conditions carefully.

1. REGISTRATION

- i. A deposit of \$2000 + \$300 G.S.T.
- ii. **Final balance plus GST plus \$300 damage deposit** is due eight weeks prior to start date.
- iii. You agree that you are not aware of any physical or other reasons which would restrict you from participating in all or any part of the semester.
- iv. You agree that Yamnuska will begin committing resources and other expenses to prepare for your participation on the semester
- v. Yamnuska may contact you in the future via email or post for feedback or marketing purposes (you can unsubscribe)

2. CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION

- A. **Waiver:** Participation is conditional upon signing the Yamnuska waiver of risk and Liability. Waiver available on website or on request.
- B. **Medical:** The medical form is for your benefit and is a way of advising us of past medical history. By registering for the semester, you agree that you are able to complete three months of demanding physical activities in what can be a harsh environment. Based on your Doctor's recommendation, we reserve the right to exclude you from certain segments of the semester. Normal cancellation policies apply. If you have doubts regarding your physical or other capabilities, you should receive your Doctor's clearance PRIOR to registering for the semester. The Medical Assessment Form does not relieve you from the booking and cancellation policies. We recognize injuries and life events after your registration may change your availability to participate fully or partially on the semester so we strongly recommend you purchase medical and trip cancellation insurance. If you do not have a current provider we can recommend one.
- C. **Refunds & Cancellations:** Many of the semester expenses are incurred and committed by Yamnuska Inc. while preparing for students to attend the semester. Our cancellation policies reflect the fact that we cannot recover most costs after late cancellations. We accept your booking in good faith and begin committing resources to make the semester a high quality educational experience for you. This is a significant investment for both Yamnuska and the student and in order for us to fulfill our obligations to you, we need to commit/incur resources and expenses on your behalf.

CANCELLATION: If canceling call Yamnuska Mountain Adventures immediately. This must be followed by notice in writing. The following cancellation penalties apply:

This deposit is to defray the cost of repairing or replacing any gear damaged or lost through student misuse or inattention. If abnormal damage or loss does not occur the deposit will be refunded at the end of the course.
- E. If tuition is not paid in full on dates due, Yamnuska may regard this as cancellation on your part.
- F. Yamnuska Mountain Adventures reserves the right to cancel courses and refund fees upon cancellation without penalty to Yamnuska Mountain Adventures.
- G. Yamnuska Mountain Adventures reserves the right to refuse admission to or expel anyone who is a danger to the environment, her/himself, or others, for gross misconduct, or who, in the opinion of the company or its agents, would be unable for any reason to satisfactorily complete the course requirements.
- H. No refunds will be given to anyone expelled from the semester for gross or persistent misconduct, illegal drug use, illegal behavior, deliberate and/or maliciously dangerous behavior.
